The Jeppesen Avionics Scholarship

Jerry Buchanan was awarded the Jeppesen Avionics Scholarship. The RAAA and Jeppesen Australia Pty Ltd invited apprentices to apply for the 2014 Jeppesen Aircraft Maintenance (Avionics) Scholarship.

Valued at \$5,000, the scholarship is awarded to encourage the continuing education of a promising aircraft maintenance engineer who has demonstrated a commitment to the aviation industry.

Candidates are asked to complete an application form, providing information such as academic progress, course attendance, special awards or achievements and progress in the workplace. They are also asked questions such as why they decided to become an aircraft maintenance engineer and what they hope to achieve. A panel comprising senior members of the RAAA and Jeppesen Australia then judges the applications.

Wagga avionics apprentice Jerry Buchanan was selected to receive the 2014 Scholarship and was presented with a certificate at the annual RAAA convention, along with his \$5,000 cheque, which he says will be used towards the completion of his diploma to become a Licensed Aircraft Maintenance Engineer.
