



## Vietnamese pilots to train at Rex Pilot Academy

**ON 16 DECEMBER** 2015, in Vietnam, Rex Group's Executive Chairman Mr Lim Kim Hai signed a pilot training agreement with Viet Flight Training (VFT – a joint venture between Bay Viet and Vietnam Airlines) on behalf of Rex subsidiary, the Australian Airline Pilot Academy (AAPA).

The signing ceremony was witnessed by Australian Ambassador to Vietnam HE Hugh Borrowman, the Deputy Director General of the

Civil Aviation Authorities Vietnam (CAAV) Mr Do Quang Viet and the General Manager, Safety – Quality – Security Department of Vietnam Airlines, Mr Au Duy Linh.

This commercial agreement represents the first time that Vietnamese cadet pilots will be trained in Australia, and the contract reaffirms AAPA's position as one of the world's best pilot training facilities.
